

Correcting an unbalanced load

Quality inspection, rework, wrapping freight



Project background

MCR stepped in to assist ATR Trading, a transportation company, when its truck from Northern Ireland arrived at Automatic Retailing in North Shields with a shipment of bottled fizzy drinks that was deemed unstable due to pallets shifting during transit.

After the load was rejected by the vending wholesaler, ATR Trading had limited options and sought out a local company to help restack or re-palletise the load in order to meet the requirements for delivery.

The team at MCR Services took on the task of reworking the load, utilising a forklift to realign some pallets against a wall and rearrange others for acceptance into its final destination.
